

How to hang a reptile light properly

Start with a safe hood



- Ceramic attachments (pictured) are safer than plastic
- Wire loop for safe hanging (NEVER hang a light by the cord)
- Wire basket helps prevent fires and/or potential burns to the animal if dropped or hanging system fails
- Color, shape and size of the dome is determined by owner and animal being cared for

Hanging stands provide stability and safety



- Hang the light vertically, never at an angle
- Make sure the cord is not resting on any part of the hood
- Use the hanging stand to adjust the height of the dome to acquire correct temperature
- Inspect monthly to ensure safe operation
